My wife grew up in western Kansas and 4-H clubs were a common part of the farming culture in her hometown of Goodland. The clubs prided themselves on developing the Heads, Hearts, Hands and Health of the participating children in each club.

At WAMM, we also have 4 "H's", but ours are intended to focus our prayer for the kids at HOME.

The first "H" is for Heaven. It is our ultimate goal and prayer that each of our children will have heaven as their final destiny through the saving power of Jesus.

The second "H" stands for Health. The children who

come into our care have a variety of special needs and physical challenges. We are praying for God to provide healing and delivery from these conditions either through medical services or through his direct healing power. In either case, we long for the provision to be undeniably from his hand.

Thirdly, we are praying for Homes. We long for each of our children to be returned to healthy family environments or placed in adoptive homes where they will find the love and care they deserve. There are four more pictures of children who need such a home on pages 2 and 3 of this newsletter .



Finally, we are praying for Happiness for our children. These kids come into our care from all kinds of unimaginably difficult backgrounds and we pray that God will grant them the joy that they may never have experienced before. His request was that we do whatever we can to demonstrate that God can and will provide for Ghanaian ministries “immediately” rather than intermediately. He wanted to see his people believe that God loves Ghanaians directly, He didn’t have to use “the whites” to show his love and care.

My prayer in 2026 is that God would accomplish this dream of 20+ years.
